Week 1: Story Land Week:



Stories play a vital role in the growth and development of children. The books they read can give them a new outlook on places, people, and situations they from whom they learn a different perspective. Children will begin to understand that books are a useful source of information and that good reading skills are important for success in many aspects of their future lives.

Week 2: Veterinarian Camp Week:
